KING MAKES IT NUMBER FOUR!!!

NOME, ALASKA -March 15, 2006 - Three-time Iditarod Champion Jeff King (Bib # 30) reached the Burlled Arch of Nome on Front Street early this morning at 01:11:36 with 12 dogs notching up his fourth Iditarod victory.

King joins an elite group of four other mushers who have distinction of winning the IDITAROD Trail Sled Dog Race 4 times. Only Martin Buser, Susan Butcher, Doug Swingley, and Rick Swenson (5 wins) can lay claim to that. One new twist in King's 4th win is that he now has the distinction of being the oldest musher to ever win the "Last Great Race to Nome" at the age of 50.

Along with his fourth Iditarod victory, King also netted \$69,000 presented by Wells Fargo and a brand new 2006 Dodge Quad Cab Cummins Diesel 4X4 Pick up truck from Anchorage Chrysler Dodge.
